





#### **Choco Muffins**



NORMAL & MAGIC INGREDIENTS

2 medium eggs

125ml vegetable oil

250ml semi-skimmed milk

200g golden caster sugar

400g self-raising flour

100g chocolate chips

- Heat oven to 200C. Line 2 muffin trays with paper muffin cases. Beat the eggs lightly with a handheld electric mixer for 1 min. Add the oil and milk and beat until just combined then add the sugar and whisk until you have a smooth batter. Sift in the flour and salt then mix until just smooth. Be careful not to over-mix the batter as this will make the muffins tough. Stir in the chocolate chips or dried fruit if using.
- Fill muffin cases two-thirds full and bake for 20-25 mins, until risen, firm to the touch and a skewer inserted in the middle comes out clean. If the trays will not fit on 1 shelf, swap the shelves around after 15 mins of cooking. Leave the muffins in the tin to cool for a few mins and transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.
